WHO MAY APPLY:

• Parent or legal guardian of children ages 14 and under may apply for toy shop assistance. (Families will receive a holiday food box and a toy for each child aged 14 and under in December.)

Seniors, aged 55 and over may apply for Christmas meal assistance.

(Seniors will receive holiday meal assistance in December.)

All applicants must reside in the Warren Corps service area:

WHAT TO BRING WHEN APPLYING:

Picture ID for all adults living in household

(If address is not current on ID, bring proof of current address with a lease agreement or utility bill.)

Birth certificates for all children living in household.

(If you do not have birth certificates, you must be able to bring a recent, official documents that verify child's date of birth and that you are the parent or legal guardian. Documents such as recent DHS case notice, shot records, school records.

etc. More than one document may be needed for verification.)

You will be asked to verify the household's monthly income on the application.

WHEN TO APPLY:

Walk in applications taken in November only on the following dates:

2nd week in November:	Nov. 12th — 16th	Monday thru Friday	10am to 4pm
3rd week in November:	Nov. 19th — 21st	Monday thru Wednesday	10am to 4pm
Last week in November:	Nov. 26th and 27th	Monday & Tuesday	10am to 4pm and also from 5:30pm to 7:30pm in evening

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- No phone applications.
- * We will take applications on 10 different days in November (see above list). There is no hurry to come on the first day of applications. The first day is usually the busiest with very long wait times.
- * You must apply in November to receive an appointment in December to receive your assistance. We will not take applications or walk-ins for assistance in December.
- * If you receive Christmas assistance from another agency, you may be denied our assistance.
- * You will be denied for assistance if you do not present the proper identification when applying.
- * If you do not live in the Warren Corps service area, you will be referred to another Salvation Army Corps that services your area. Assigned areas go by the zip code you live in.
