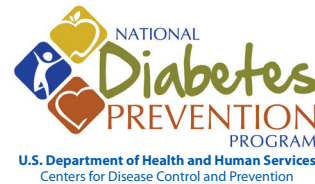


YOU CAN MAKE A CHANGE FOR LIFE
