## Important Voting Dates For the Presidential Primary

February 24, 2020	Last day to register for an absentee ballot
February 25 - March 10, 2020	In-person registration with proof of residency with local clerk's office
March 10, 2020	Presidential Primary

## Registration and Absentee Voting

- ★ Due to a new law passed, all individuals who are eligible and registered to vote in Michigan may now request an absentee voter ballot without providing a reason.
- ★ To request an absentee voter ballot, you must contact your local clerk's office no later than 5:00 p.m. on the Friday before the election: Friday, March 6th.
- ★ Once your request is received by the local clerk, your signature on the request will be checked against your voter registration record.
- ★ After receiving your absentee voter ballot, you have until 8:00 p.m. on the day of the election to complete and return it to the clerk's office.
