

Oakland County has established a “**Save your Spot**” registration to get in line for the COVID-19 vaccine. Once the Oakland County Health Division has available vaccine doses, they will then contact you by phone, text or email.

To register, please go to <https://oaklandcountyvaccine.com/> and click on the **blue box COMPLETE FORM: SAVE YOUR SPOT**. After completing the form, you will receive an email from Oakland County as follows:

This email **confirms** you have successfully completed the “**Save Your Spot**” form. When you are eligible to set an appointment and vaccine doses are available, the Oakland County Health Division will contact you by phone, text, or email. Your invitation to schedule an appointment will come from saveyourspot@oakgov.com. If you found this confirmation email in your spam/junk email folder, be sure to mark the message as “Not Spam” or [add the email address to your safe sender list](#). This will help ensure that you’ll receive the email invitation to set a vaccination appointment when we send it. You should frequently check your spam/junk email folder to look for messages that your email filter has incorrectly marked as spam.
