

## Macomb County Limited English Proficiency & Cultural Competency Online Instructions

- ExpertCare will register you with Macomb County’s online training system, *Relias*
  - You will receive an email from ExpertCare with your username and password. Please ensure you store your username and password, as you will need it to update trainings in the future
  - Limited English Proficiency (LEP) will need to be completed every 2 years
  - Cultural Competency (CC) must be completed annually
  - Please allow approximately 30 minutes for each training
1. Visit <http://mccmh.training.reliaslearning.com>
  2. Login with provided username and password  
*Username format* is First Name.Last Name  
*Password format* is the date you were enrolled into Relias – xx/xx/xxxx
  3. Click “**Current Training**” tab
  4. MCCMH-Cultural Competency Training - Click the “**Take Now**” box
    - You must receive 80% of above to pass
    - You may retake training if you do not pass initially
    - You must complete the survey at the end of the quiz to receive certificate
  5. MCCMH-Limited English Proficiency Training – Click the “**Take Now**” box
    - You must receive 80% of above to pass
    - You may retake training if you do not pass initially
    - You must complete the survey at the end of the quiz to receive certificate
      - a. Under “**Lessons and Exams**”, click on the MCCMH Limited English Proficiency training – read each slide
      - b. Under “**Lessons and Exams**”, click “**Start**” Final Exam
  6. Submit Training
    - a. At the top of the page, click on “**My Learning**”
    - b. Click on the “**Transcript**” tab
    - c. Click on the small certificate icon under each completed training
    - d. Submit both Limited English Proficiency and Cultural Competency certificate either via fax or email
